HISTORY



Alamo

The second oldest township in Contra Costa County, Alamo offers stylish living with city-close convenience and miles of equestrian trails. It is a low density town with custom homes, ranches and contemporary houses on large, hilly lots. For the most part, it is considered home by the area's top and rising executives.

Alamo is an unincorporated township, which means it is governed by county bureaucrats from Martinez. Occasionally there is talk about incorporating Alamo as a city with its own city council. However, it is commonly felt that most residents would vote against incorporation. There are no neighborhood parks. Generally, however, the townships' residents can afford their own tennis courts and pools.

The highly rated San Ramon Valley Unified School District provides elementary, intermediate and high school education. Achievement test scores consistently rank in the top 10 percentiles among California schools.

Historic Downtown Danville

Hartz Ave, Prospect Street, School and Church Street. The original railroad hotel was later called the Danville Hotel and moved to this location. This two-story English Frame hotel was built soon after the railroad came to Danville in 1891, in 1927 was turned around and placed on Hartz Avenue. It was dedicated November 19, 1977. This area has many quaint local shops and Heritage Houses.

Eugene O'Neill National Historic Site

Located in Danville, CA

Eugene Gladstone O'Neill, the only Nobel Prize winning playwright from the United States and the architect of modern American theater, lived at Tao House in the hills above Danville from 1937 to 1944. It was at this site that he wrote his final and most successful plays; "The Iceman Cometh," "Long Days Journey Into Night," and "A Moon For the Misbegotten." Since 1980, the National Park Service has been restoring Tao House, its' courtyard and orchards and telling the story of O'Neill, his work and his influence on American theater. **Reservations required.**
